

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS YAMAHA ATV WINCH MOUNTING KIT

Application: 2004 YAMAHA BRUIN 350

As you read these instructions, you will see NOTES, CAUTIONS and WARNINGS. Each message has a specific purpose. NOTES are additional information to help you complete a procedure. (FOR ROLLER FAIRLEAD AND CAST HAWSE FAIRLEAD)
3/8 Allen Wrench
(FOR CAST HAWSE FAIRLEAD)

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INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Remove 4 skid pan bolts as shown in Figure 1.
- 2. Place winch mount into position inside of the front grab bar. See Figure 2.
- 3. Place u-bolt spacer into position between the front winch mount mounting holes, and place u-bolt over the front grab bar cross bar, through spacer, into front winch mount slotted holes. Secure using flat washer, and lock nut. Hand tighten only at this time. See Figure 3.

- 4. Move winch mount to ensure holes in the winch mount line-up closely with the holes in the grab bar winch mounting tabs.
- 5. Assemble roller fairlead or cast hawse to mounting bracket. Securely tighten bolts.
- 6. Place winch into position. See Figure 4.
- 7. Secure winch using 4, 5/16-18 x 1.00 winch mount bolts and lock washers found in winch kit.

NOTE: If mounting 3.0ci winch, use spacers (P/N 68324) between mounting plate and winch and secure winch using 5/16-18 x 1 ¼ hex head cap screws included with winch mounting kit. See Figure 5.





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- 8. Tighten winch mounting fasteners to 17 ft. lbs. of torque
- 9. Tighten u-bolts securely at this time to 7 ft. lbs. of torque.
- 10. Complete wiring installation per wiring instructions found in manual included with winch kit.
